Conduct an audit of your home to establish what cleaners you have at home. With an adult's help complete the audit sheet to see which are toxic.

Use the data sheet on the back to record your findings.

Make a list of the cleaning products you find in your home and what **Warning Words** you find on the label. To determine hazard level of the product, use the following chart to understand what the label means.

Warning Word	Hazard level	What the label means
POISON	Most Dangerous	Highly toxic
DANGER		Extremely flammable, corrosive or highly toxic
WARNING		Moderate hazard
CAUTION	Least Dangerous	Mild or moderate hazard



Conclusion: What do your findings show about the air quality health in your home, related to the cleaning products used?
